Intent - We aim to:

Inspire children by exploring the works of artists and designers.

Develop an understanding of how art is a form of self-expression and what can be communicated through art.

Explore cultural and historical developments of different art forms and their impacts.

Implementation - How do we achieve our aims?

Creativity through a variety of different mediums

- Use a range of materials to design and make products
- Develop a wide range of techniques such as colour, texture, shape, line, form and space
- Explore art mediums (including digital) and use that to share ideas and imagination

Inspire children by exploring the works of artists and designers

- Explore a wide range of art through different contexts
- Evaluate and analyse creative work using language associated with art
- Describe similarities and differences between different practitioners and their practices and make links to own work

Explore cultural and historical developments of different art forms

- Use a range of art to discuss links between art, history and culture
- Explore how history and culture has influenced others to create art
- Develop an understanding how art has developed through history

Develop an understanding of how art is a form of self-expression and what can be communicated through art.

- Encourage using art as a form of self-expression
- Provide children with opportunities to use their imagination to aid them to use their skills in creative ways
- Provide opportunities for children to engage in discussions about how art makes them feel
- Discuss how artists have communicated through their art
- Promote an encouraging environment where children can express and experiment
